Extra recyclable materials may be placed in another container next to bin.


Do not use trash bags for recycling.

PAPER

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Newspaper (including inserts)
- Magazines, Catalogs, Phone Books
- Corrugated Boxes
- Paperboard Boxes (Cereal-no bag liners)
- Junk Mail, Envelopes, Office Paper
- Shredded Paper (sealed in bag)
- Pizza Boxes (no liners, remove all food)

PREPARATION

Put loose paper in a grocery bag & place underneath heavier items in bin.

Flatten corrugated & paperboard boxes. Leave flattened larger corrugated boxes next to bin.

NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Foil Paper (Candy, Cookie, Chip Wrappers)
- Napkins, Tissues, Paper Towels, Waxed
- Used Paper Plates, Pizza Liners
- Wax Coated Boxes (Milk, Juice, Butter, etc)
- Plastic Lined Pet Food Bags
- Wrapping & Tissue Paper
- Dryer Sheets
- Any Paper With Food or Oil Stains

METAL

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Steel & Tin Cans & Lids
- Aerosol Cans (empty)
- Aluminum Cans, Foil Trays, Foil
- Bake Ware & Utensils
- Pots & Pans
- Wire Hangers
- Scrap Metal
- Christmas Lights
- Propane Containers

PREPARATION

Rinse clean, empty aerosol cans

NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Paint Cans

NOT RECYCLABLE

- Glass, Dishes, Ceramics
- Light Bulbs, Fluorescents
- SHARPS (Needles, Razor Blades)
- Medications, Batteries

PLASTIC

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Plastic CONTAINERS #1,#2, #4, #5, #7
- Milk Jugs, Water Bottles, Juice
- Shampoo, Detergent, coffee

PREPARATION

Rinse clean & flatten if possible

NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Automotive Fluids
- Hazardous Materials Containers
- Styrofoam
- Plastic Bags & Film
