The following preamble and resolution was offered by Baumann and seconded by Filkins .

WHEREAS, under Section 45 of the Michigan Planning Enabling Act, Public Act 33 of 2008, MCL 125.3803 et seq. (the "MPEA"), at least every 5 years after adoption of a master plan, a planning commission shall review the master plan and determine whether to commence the procedure to amend the master plan or adopt a new master plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the MPEA, the City Planning Commission has reviewed the City's master plan and determined that no amendments to it are necessary nor is a new master plan necessary at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Planning Commission of the City of Cadillac, Wexford County, Michigan, resolves as follows:

1. The City's current master plan remains in effect without amendment.

2. If the City determines to revisit the master plan at a later time, it will comply with provisions of the MPEA regarding the procedure to amend the master plan and/or adopt a new master plan.

3. Any and all resolutions that are in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed but only to the extent to give this Resolution full force and effect.
